“Reconstruction” Is Still Ongoing

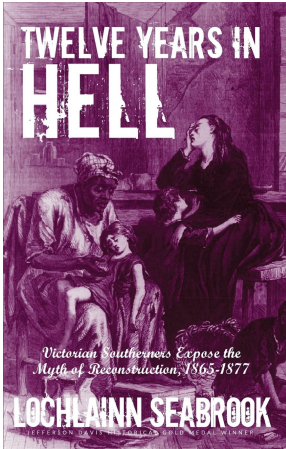

When the topic of Yankee "reconstruction" comes up many of us remember the words of Karl Marx when he called for "the reconstruction of a social world" in the American South after the War of Northern Aggression, which really ended up being the War of Yankee (Deep State) reconstruction. Undoubtedly, the Illuminists that hired Karl Marx to pen the "Communist Manifesto" were aware of this.

Reconstruction, understood in its proper perspective, was never a plan to really reconstruct a South torn down by the Northern invaders. It was really a plan to beat the South into total submission and completely humiliate it in the process. Lew Rockwell, in his article on <https://www.lewrockwell.com> for December 25th of this year, observed: "As Tom DiLorenzo says 'The main purpose (and effect) of the 1865-1877 'reconstruction' policies was to centralize and consolidate power and to establish Republican Party political hegemony. It was NOT to heal the nation's wounds or economically revitalize the South. Indeed, Reconstruction created new wounds and economically destroyed the South. Its purpose was to continue the economic plundering of the Southern states for as long as possible, and to establish a national Republican Party political monopoly.'" "Noble" aspiration, right?

Lew then went into information on the evils of the 14th Amendment, which I am told was never legally ratified. And later on, he noted: "The result of these draconian measures was a regime of total corruption. New state legislatures dominated by the radicals and their supporters, imposed exorbitant property taxes on white owners. Sometimes they confiscated their land, in order to turn it over to their own supporters. The new legislatures voted themselves benefits with complete financial abandon." He then went into the ethnic genocide perpetrated on the American Indians in the West in order to make way for the railroads. Lew noted that "The record of tyranny in Reconstruction is terrifying."



Lochlainn Seabrook, in his book, "Twelve Years In Hell" has observed the exact same thing. Quoting Confederate Postmaster General John H. Reagan, who said: "The plan adopted for the restoration of the Union and the pacification of the Southern people was to deprive them of all political rights, put them under military rule, and suspend the right of the writ of habeas corpus, so that there could be no relief or redress for any wrong done to a citizen, however unlawful or outrageous. Our citizens were subject to arrest by the military authority without an affidavit or formal charge, or legal warrant, and to detention, without knowing what the charges against them were and to a trial by a drumhead court martial without the intervention of a jury." Sounds like what went on in

Communist countries during the heyday of the Soviet Empire. Don't suppose the Soviet Communists learned from this country do you?

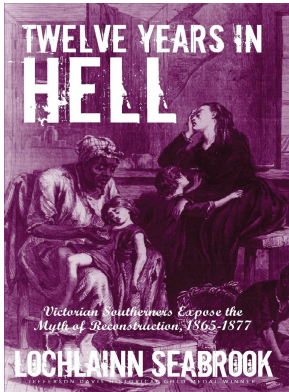
After the War of Northern Aggression and the Indian wars, this country went on to "reconstruct" Hawaii, the Philippines, Cuba and a few other places, always claiming that all these places were "better off" for the "Reconstruction" practiced by the United States. Sure they were--just like the American South was "better off" after being pummeled and plundered by the Republican Regime under Lincoln, Stanton, Stevens and Sumner.

"Reconstruction" continued after the First World War, with outfits like the Council on Foreign Relations formed to help it along because the US Congress at that time was, for some reason, not as fully "reconstructed" as the Deep State could have wished and so it resoundingly voted down the US entering into the League of Nations. You might say that Woodrow Wilson was the Abraham Lincoln of his day and time and so, with the help of his alter ego, Edward Mandell House and others, we got the Council on Foreign Relations--the ultimate tool of "Reconstruction."

Reconstructing the entire US was a thorny task and so we had to have another

World War to get it accomplished and the CFR needed some help with the reconstruction process. Enter the United Nations--the ultimate vehicle for the total "Reconstruction" of the United States and the rest of the world as well. The UN had what it thought was the ultimate "Reconstruction" plan--submerging this country into yet one more socialist cog in its New World Order. And you have lots of Congress critters currently in office who are totally okay with that and a handful who are not. The Deep State is busily trying to force this latest version of "Reconstruction" upon us and they feel, with "Brain-dead Biden" in office, if he can steal just one more election, they might make it. - To maintain dictatorial control over Dixie, the new Radical Left Republican government, headed by Liberal U.S. President Ulysses S. Grant, illegally weaponized the police, the courts, and the military.
